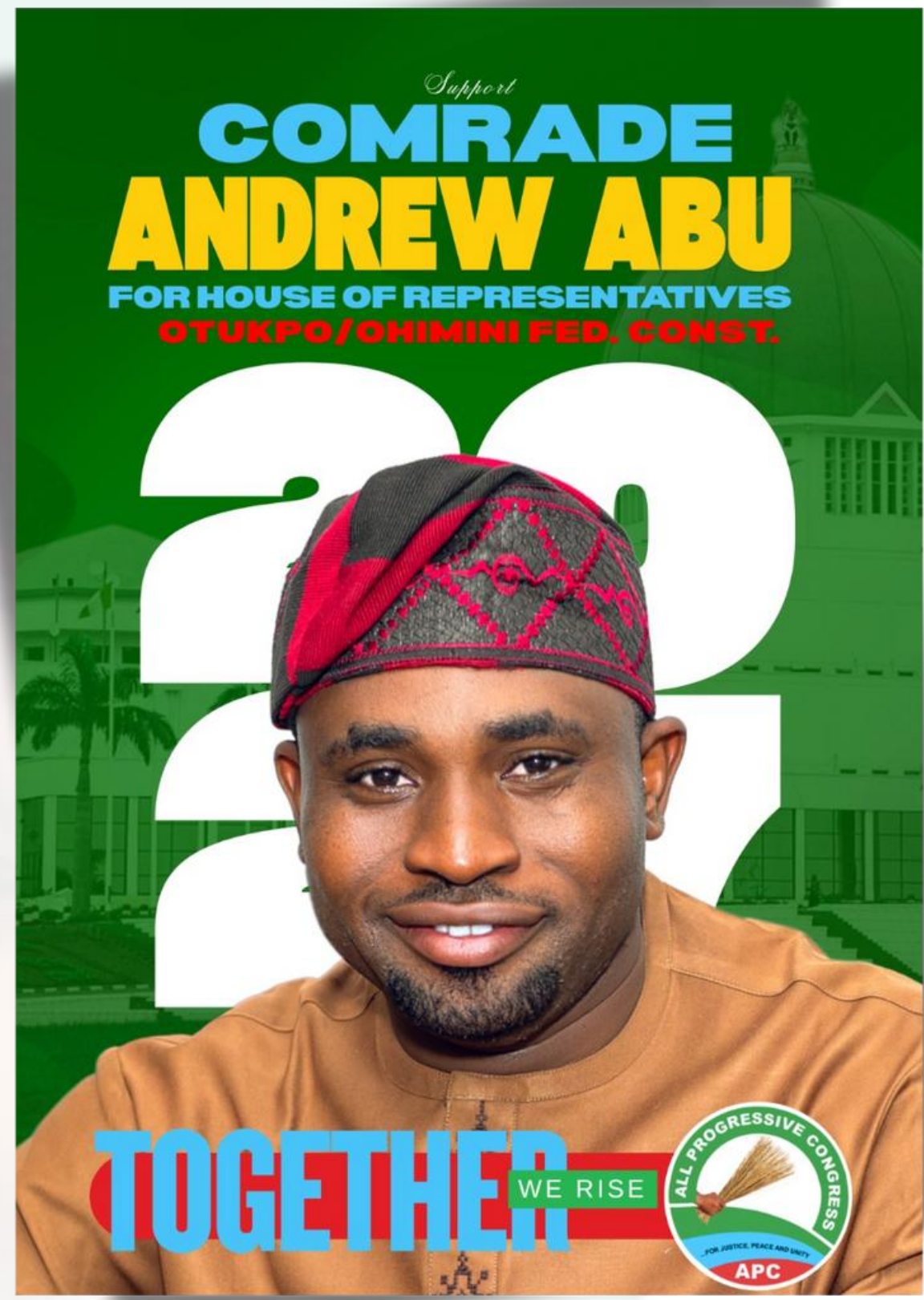

FOREWORD

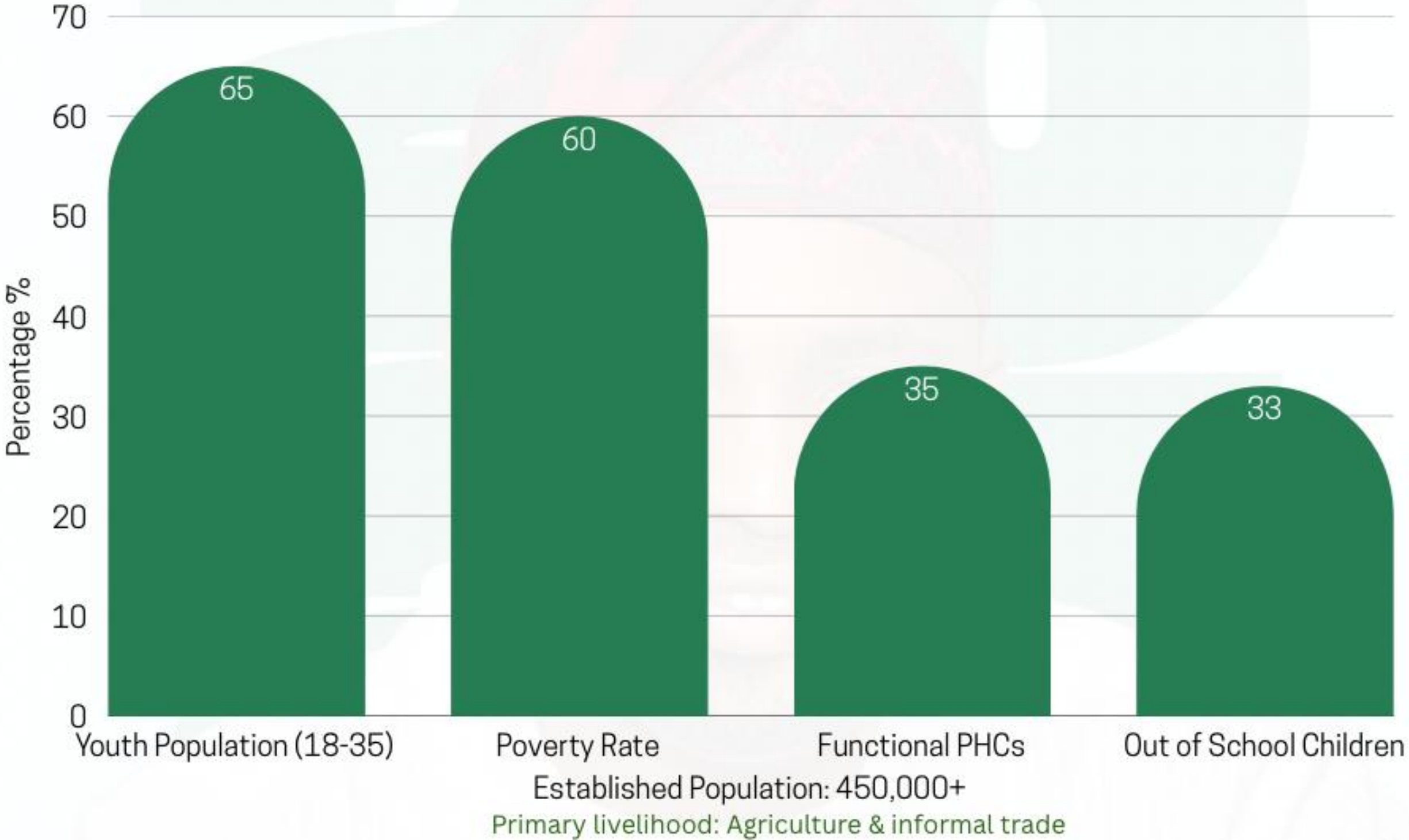

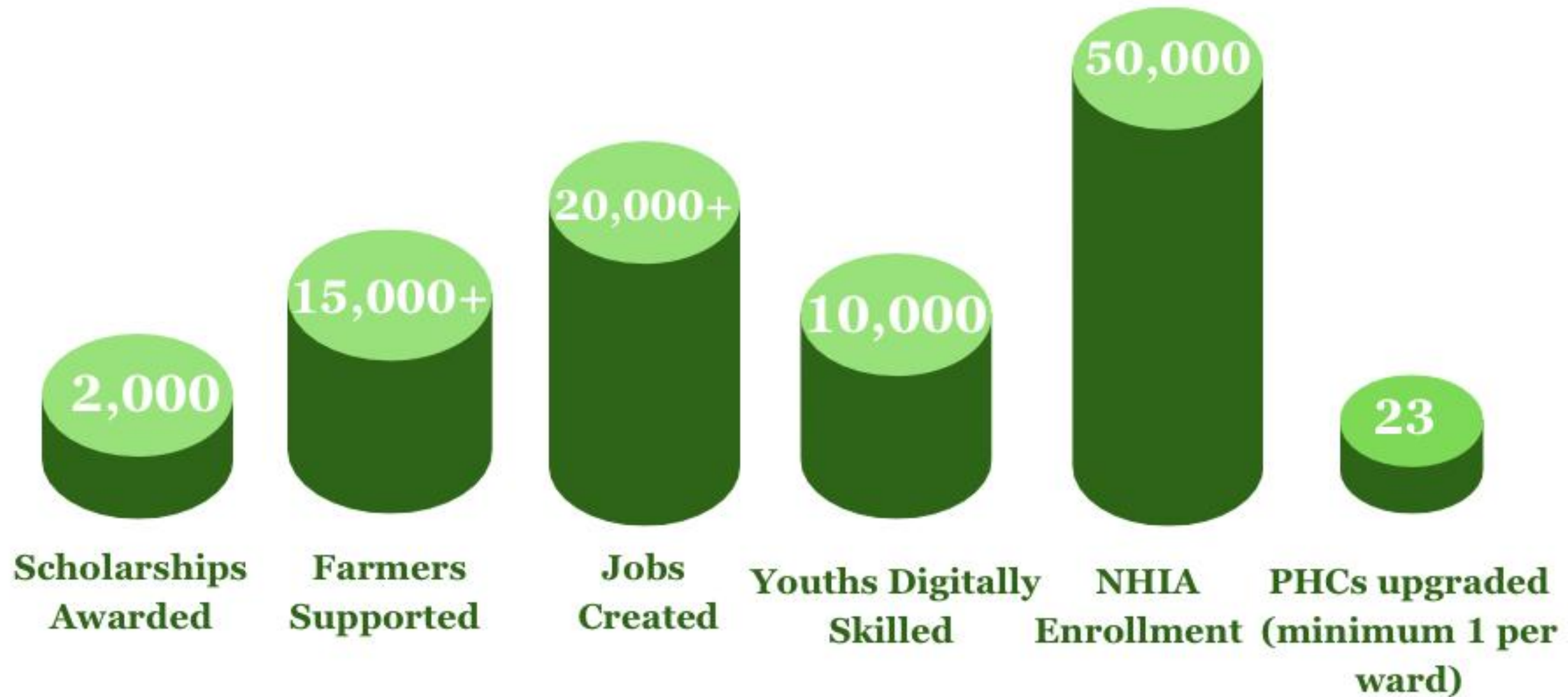
